Fundraising Activities

Grocery Certificates – Earn money for your student's account while grocery shopping. Purchase certificates for Hollywood Market and/or Oakridge Market.

Our local grocery stores (Hollywood and Oakridge) will work with us by providing "gift certificates" that can be redeemed for the amount specified on the face of the certificate. They will in turn donate 5% of that amount back to the choir committee. 4% will be placed in your student's account and 1% goes to the general account. This can add up to be a great benefit to your student's account and the ROHS general account.

For example:

You purchase \$400.00 worth of gift certificates from Hollywood. Your student's account will receive \$16.00. The general account will receive \$4.00.
